

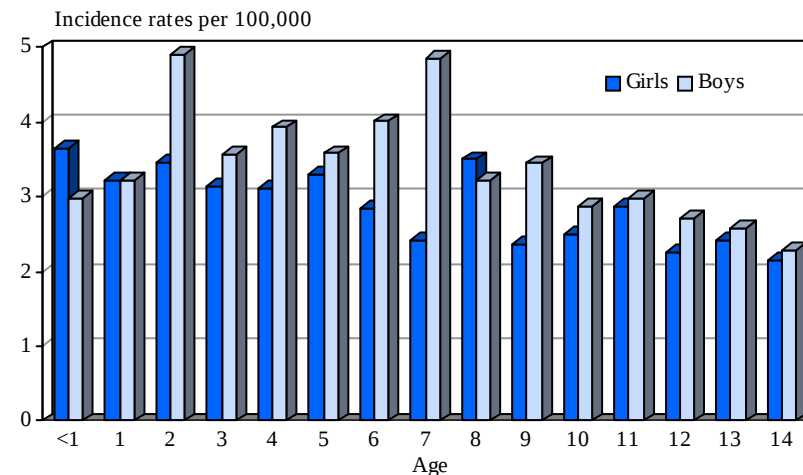

5-, 10-, and 15-year survival probabilities (life table estimates according to (8)): 68 %, 62 %, and 57 %

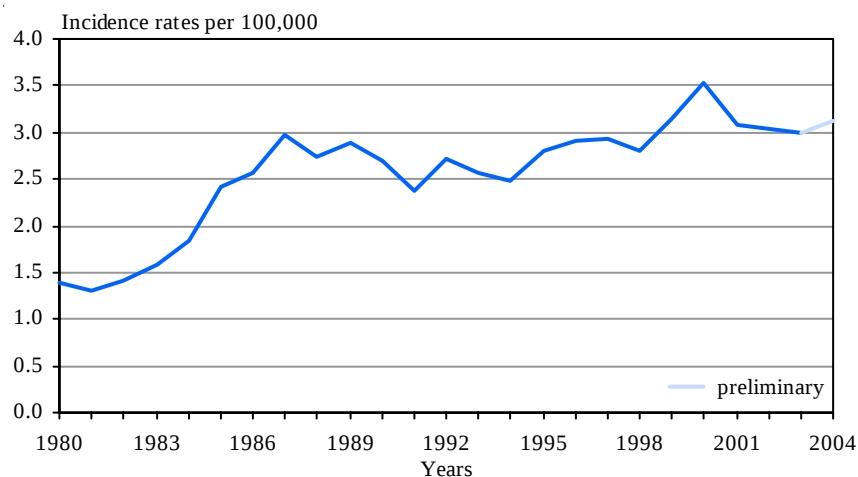
