

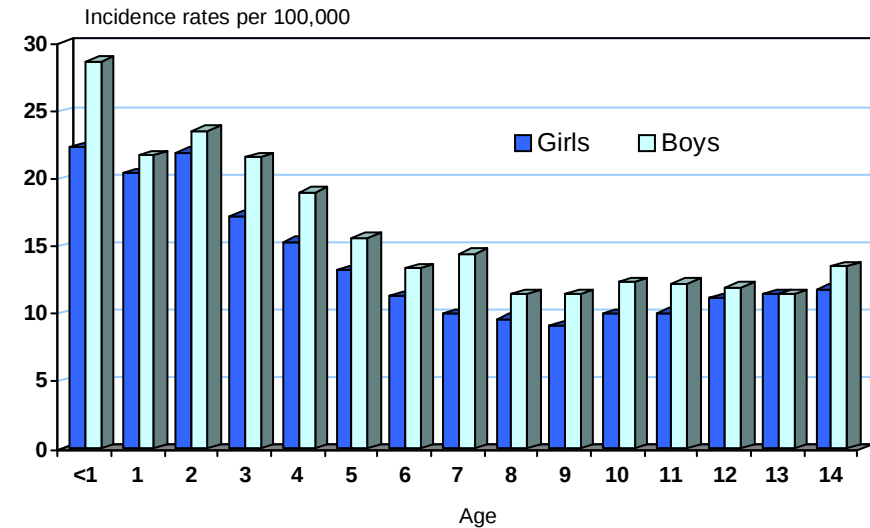

 5-, 10-, and 15-year survival probabilities: 76%, 72% and 71%

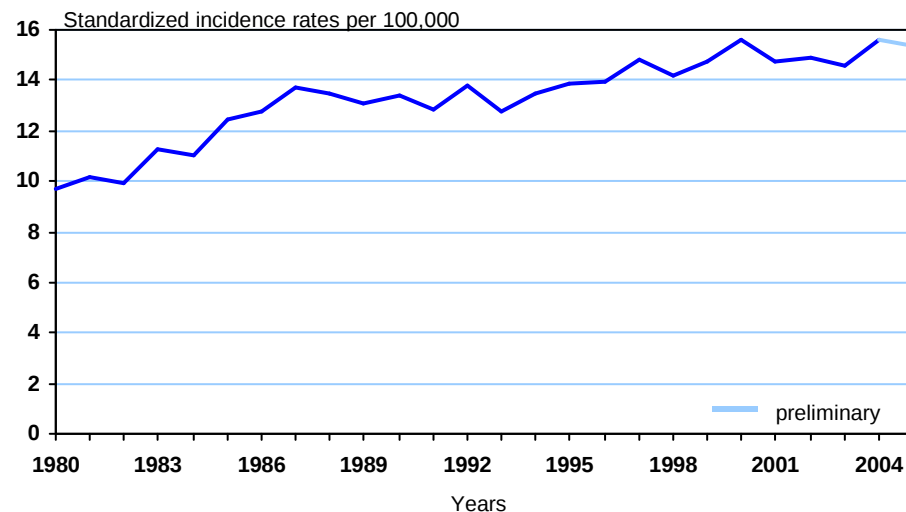
