Cases in Germany aged under 15 years based on ICC-3

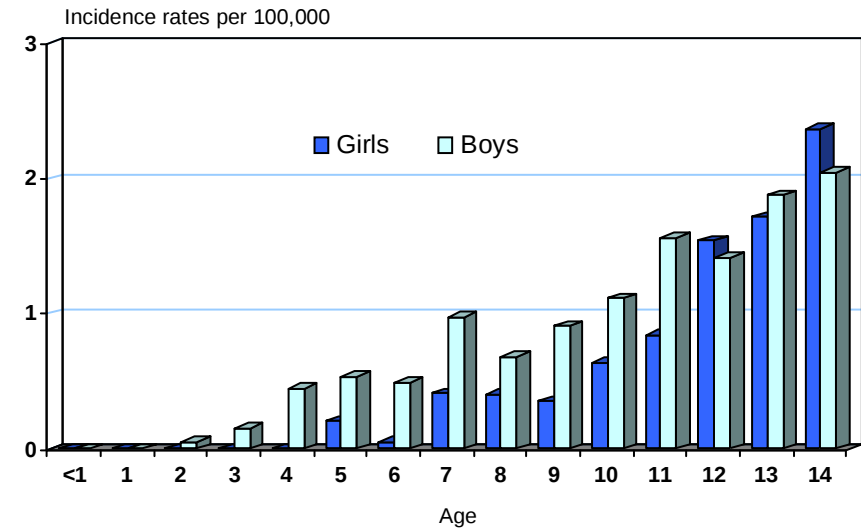
Total number of cases in the registry (1980-2005): 1956

5-, 10-, and 15-year survival probabilities: 96%, 94% and 93%

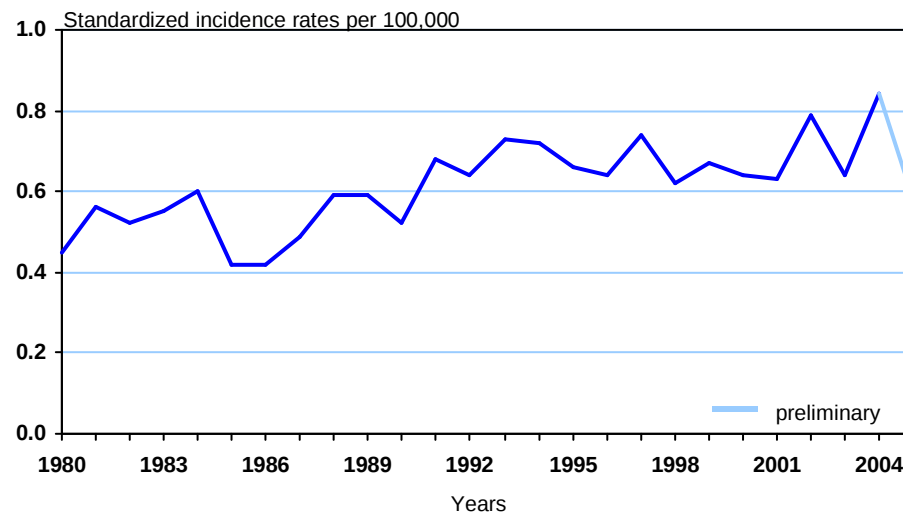
