Cases in Germany aged under 15 years based on ICC-3

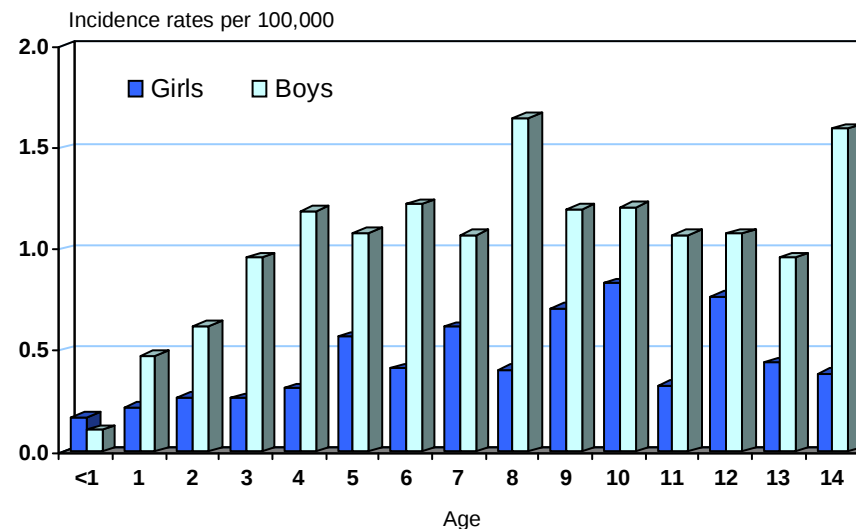

5-, 10-, and 15-year survival probabilities: 84%, 83% and 81%

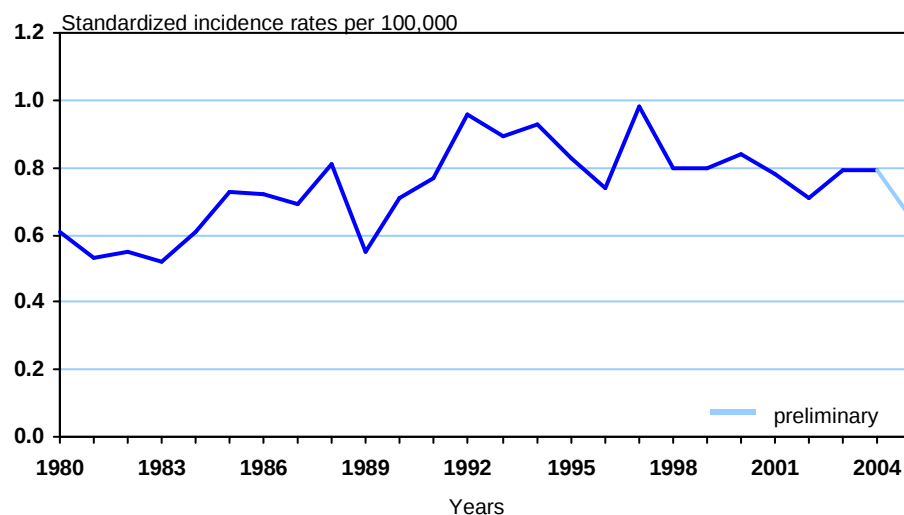
