Cases in Germany aged under 15 years based on ICCC-3

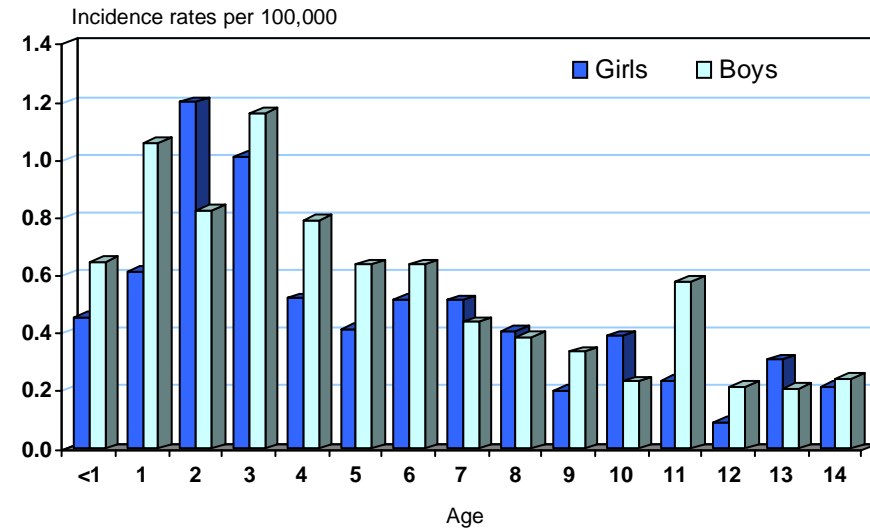

5-, 10-, and 15-year survival probabilities: 67%, 64% and 63%

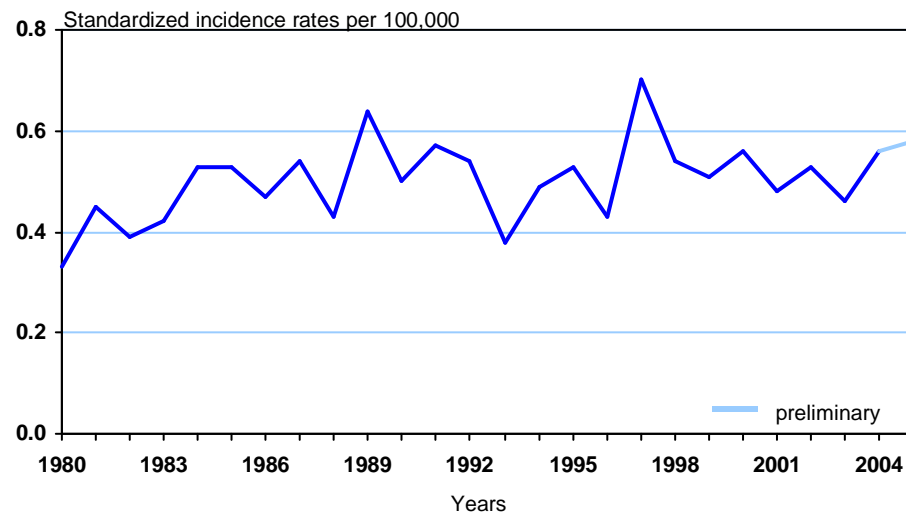
