Cases in Germany aged under 15 years based on ICC-3

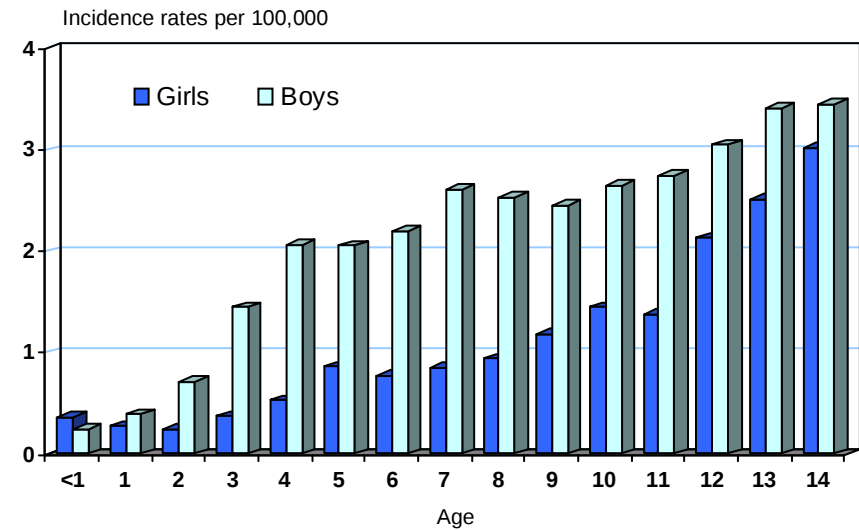

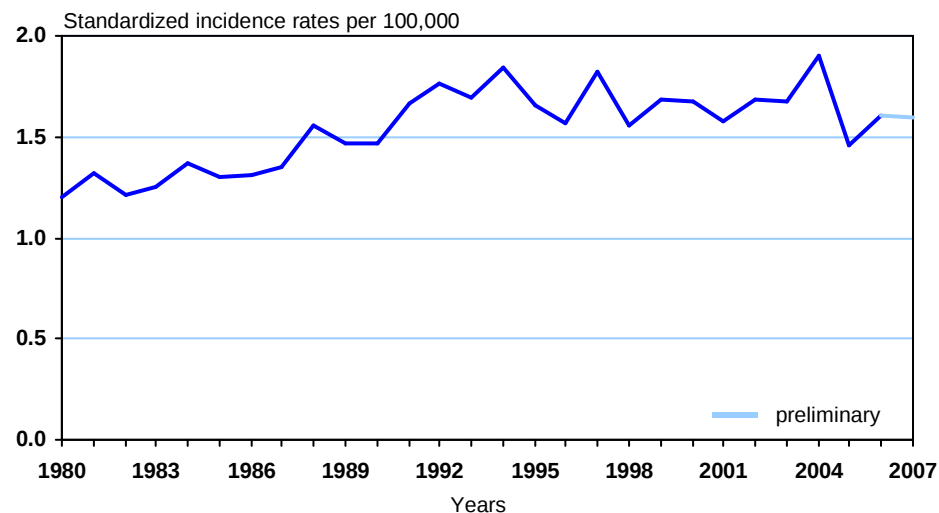
