Cases in Germany aged under 15 years based on ICCC-3

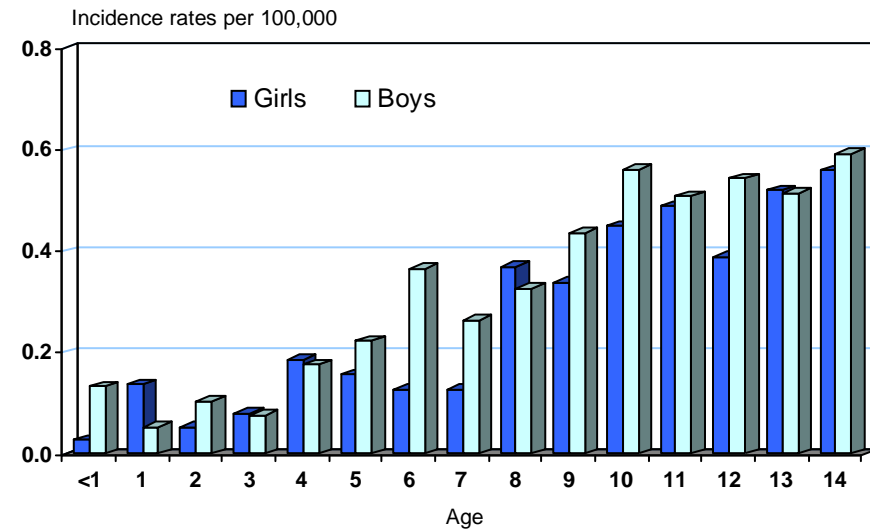
Total number of cases in the registry (1980-2007): 912

5-, 10-, and 15-year survival probabilities (1998-2007): 67%, 58% and 58%

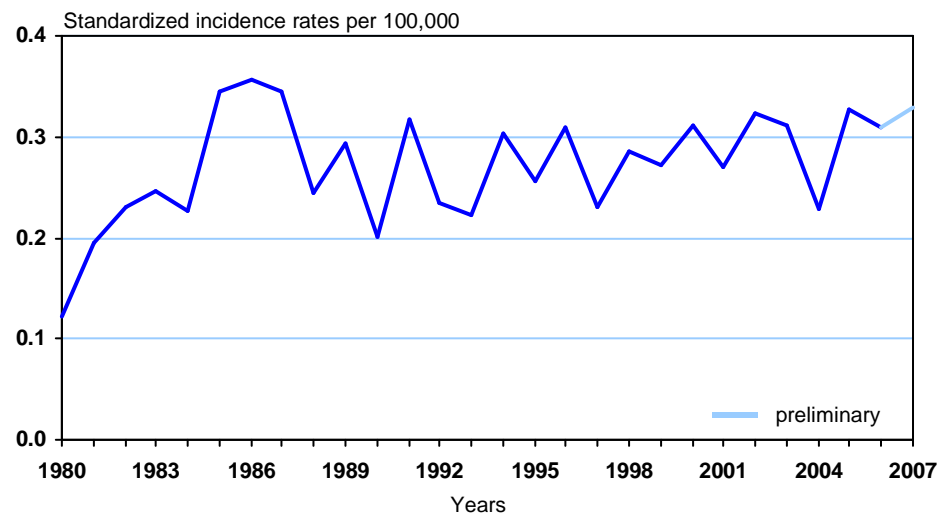
